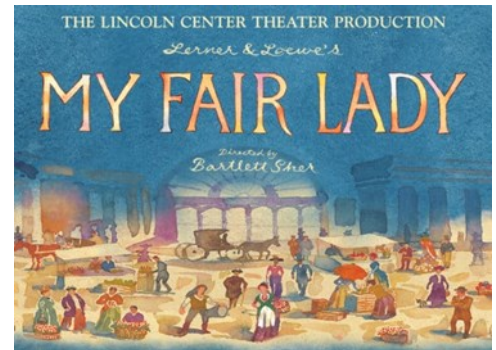
On March 11th, 31 retirees and guests enjoyed a good lunch and the musical "The Bikinis" at the Day Trippers Theatre.
